Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your student's test history becomes a part of their official transcript and passing all parts of the Georgia High School Graduation Test is a requirement for graduation. All colleges, technical schools, and branches of the military require a copy of the student's transcript as a part of the admission process. We feel certain that you want your student's transcript to indicate the best testing performance possible.

To that end we have been given the opportunity to offer the summer retest of the Georgia High School Graduation Test at Shiloh High School.

The tests will begin at **8:00 AM** in the **Theater** the week of **July 13th – 17th**. Complimentary breakfast will be served. **Late arrivals will not be able to test.** Based on your student's current test scores your child needs to retake the following tests:

- Language Arts** – Monday, July 13th
- Science** – Tuesday, July 14th
- Writing** – Wednesday, July 15th
- Social Studies** – Thursday, July 16th
- Math** – Friday, July 17th

- Math** – Friday, July 17th (Student passed the math portion of the test but there are indications that they have areas of weaknesses on specific math strands and would benefit from review and retest to increase scores reported on official transcripts.)

Research shows that when students attend review classes they have a higher success rate on the test than those who do not attend the class. We **highly recommend** that your student attends the **Math and/or Language Arts review sessions**. Review classes will be held at Shiloh High School beginning at **9:00 A.M.** Your student should report to the **commons area** for the following review session(s):

- Language Arts** – Friday, July 10th 9:00 AM – 12:00
- Math** – Wednesday, July 15th 9:00 AM – 12:00

These review classes will be taught by some of our best teachers and will focus on your child's areas for growth. Don't miss out on this exciting opportunity for your student.
